GRANTS OF TOWN ALLOTMENTS.

THE following descriptions of GRANTS OF TOWN ALLOTMENTS, with the names of the persons to whom they were originally promised, or by whom they are now claimed, are published for general information, in order that all parties concerned may have an opportunity of correcting any errors or omissions, which may have been made inadvertently.

It is requested that *within three months* from the present date the particulars required by the Government Notice of 1st October, 1838, may be accurately furnished to this office, viz.

Surname, all Christian names, and residence of the person in whose favor the Deed is to be prepared, written at full length.

Also (if required in any name but that of the original promisee), the grounds of the claims; and a letter from the said promisee, if living, and from all intermediate assigns, if any, giving his and their consent and sanction thereto, and witnessed by a Magistrate, or by a Solicitor of the Supreme Court.

If these be duly furnished, and satisfactory, and no caveat be lodged, or other cause of uncertainty appear, the Deeds will be prepared accordingly as soon as possible after the expiration of the stated period of three months for such of the said allotments as are not reserved or already granted.

If the required particulars be not furnished within that period, or if a caveat be lodged, or other cause of uncertainty arise, which cannot be satisfactorily determined by the Government, the case will be referred to the Commissioners of Claims, and the parties subjected to the expense of that proceeding.
