PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency SIR GEORGE GIPPS, Knight, Captain General and Governor-in-Chief, of the Territory of New South Wales and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same &c. &c. &c.

WHEREAS, by a certain Act or Ordinance of the Governor and Legislative Council, passed in the Second Year of the Reign of Her Majesty QUEEN VICTORIA, intituled "An Act for Regulating the Police in the Towns of Parramatta, Windsor, Maitland, Bathurst, and other Towns, respectively; and for the removing and preventing nuisances, and obstructions, and for the better alignment of streets therein," it was amongst other things enacted, that whenever the Governor, or Acting Governor, for the time-being shall deem it expedient to extend the same to any other Town in the said Colony, it shall and may be lawful for the said Governor, or Acting Governor, for the time being to declare the same by Proclamation, Now, therefore, I, the Governor in pursuance of the power and Authority so vested in me by the said recited Act, by this my Proclamation, do hereby direct that the provisions of the said Act be extended to the town of Macquarie in the County of Macquarie.

Given under my Hand at Government House, Sydney, this Twenty-first day of November, in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty nine
