14. CAMDEN, 115, One hundred and fifteen acres, parish unnamed, *near Mittagong*; commencing at the old road from Keighran's to Mittagong, at the south-east corner of Foster's 80 acres; and bounded on the west by that farm, being a line bearing north 53 chains to the Great South Road; on the north by that road, being a line bearing north 53 degrees, east 12 chains to the village reserve; on the north by that reserve being a line bearing east 15 chains to the old road from Keighran's to Mittagong; and on the east by that road to the south-east corner of Foster's 80 acres, as aforesaid.
