**PROCLAMATION.**

By His Excellency SIR GEORGE GIPPS, Knight,  
Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the  
Territory of New South Wales and its Depen-  
dencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS in pursuance of the provisions of  
an Act of the Imperial Parliament of Great  
Britain and Ireland, passed in the fifth and sixth year  
of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act for the*  
*Government of New South Wales and Van*  
*Diemen's Land,*" and in pursuance of the power  
delegated to me by Her Majesty in that behalf, I did  
by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Colony,  
appoint John Blaxland, Esquire, to be a non-elective  
Member of the Legislative Council, by the said Act es-  
tablished; and whereas the said John Blaxland, Esquire  
hath, by a writing under his hand, addressed to me, re-  
signed his seat in the said Legislative Council: Now  
I, Sir George Gipps, the Governor aforesaid, do hereby  
proclaim, that in pursuance of the authority in me  
vested, I have, by Letters Patent, under the Great  
Seal of the Colony, bearing even date herewith, ap-  
pointed George Allen, Esquire, of Toxteth Park, Syd-  
ney, to be a non-elective Member of the said Legisla-  
tive Council, in lieu of the said John Blaxland, Esquire,  
and until Her Majesty's pleasure shall be known.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at Govern-  
ment House, Sydney, this 28th day of July,  
in the year of Our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and forty-five, and in the  
ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
