PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency SIR GEORGE GIPPS, Knight, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Territory of New South Wales and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c.

HEREAS in pursuance of the provisions of an Act of the Imperial Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the fifth and sixth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for the "Government of New South Wales and Van Diemen's Land," and in pursuance of the power delegated to me by Her Majesty in that behalf, I did by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Colony, appoint John Blaxland, Esquire, to be a non-elective Member of the Legislative Council, by the said Act established; and whereas the said John Blaxland, Fsquire hath, by a writing under his hand, addressed to me, resigned his seat in the said Legislative Council: Now I, Sir Gorge Gipps, the Governor aforesaid, do hereby proclaim, that in pursuance of the authority in me vested, I have, by Letters Patent, under the Great Seal of the Colony, bearing even date herewith, appointed George Allen, Esquire, of Toxteth Park, Sydney, to be a non-elective Member of the said Legislative Council, in lieu of the said John Blaxland, Esquire, and until Her Majesty's pleasure shall be known.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at Government House, Sydney, this 28th dayof July, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, and in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency SIR GEORGE GIPPS, Knight, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Territory of New South Wales and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c.

7 HEREAS in pursuance of the provisions of an Act of the Imperial Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the fifth and sixth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for the "Government of New South Wales and Van "Diemen's Land," and in pursuance of the power delegated to me by Her Majesty in that behalf, I did by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the Colony, appoint John Blaxland, Esquire, to be a non-elective Member of the Legislative Council, by the said Act established; and whereas the said John Blaxland, Esquire hath, by a writing under his hand, addressed to me, resigned his seat in the said Legislative Council: Now I, Sir Gorge Gipps, the Governor aforesaid, do hereby proclaim, that in pursuance of the authority in me vested, I have, by Letters Patent, under the Great Seal of the Colony, bearing even date herewith, appointed George Allen, Esquire, of Toxteth Park, Sydney, to be a non-elective Member of the said Legislative Council, in lieu of the said John Blaxland, Esquire, and until Her Majesty's pleasure shall be known.
