**W**HEREAS, by an Act of the Governor and Council of New South Wales, passed in the Fourth Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled "*An Act for the Regulation of Gaols, Prisons, and Houses of Correction, in the Colony of New South Wales and its Dependencies, and for other purposes relating thereto*," it is enacted: That all buildings, erections, houses, and premises, which should thereafter be erected, built, purchased, enlarged, or maintained at the public expense, as and for public Gaols, Prisons, and Houses of Correction, within the said Colony and its Dependencies, and which should by Proclamation to be from time to time published in the New South Wales *Government Gazette*, by order of the Governor for the time being of the said Colony, be declared and notified as such public Gaols, Prisons, or Houses of Correction, should from and after the publication of such notification, be severally deemed and taken to be the public Gaol of the place or district, where the same was or should be situated within the said Colony or its Dependencies respectively; and should be subject to the several provisions thereafter made for the regulation, management, care and discipline of the public Gaols, Prisons, and Houses of Correction belonging to the said Colony and its Depen-

dencies, and of the Prisoners confined within the same; And whereas it is expedient that the building now called and known as the Western Gaol, in the City of Melbourne, in the Colony of Victoria, should be and be declared as a House of Correction: Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant Governor aforesaid, by virtue of the said recited Act, and in furtherance of the power and authority thereby in me vested, and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf; do hereby proclaim, declare, and notify the Building known as the "Western Gaol," in the City of Melbourne, in the Colony of Victoria aforesaid, to be a House of Correction.
