And I do, with the advice aforesaid, order and direct that the aforesaid Northern Circuit District shall consist of all parts of the Colony of Victoria, comprehended within the following limits:—that is to say, commencing on the dividing range at the source of the river Avoca; thence by the dividing range, being the southern boundary of the county of Talbot, to the source of the river Coliban; thence by that river including the whole of the township of Malmesbury on either side of the river Coliban to its confluence with the river Campaspe; thence by the rivers Campaspe and Murray to a point north of the north western boundary of the township of Swaw Hill; thence to Lake Baal Baal, and by the Avoca river to its source on the dividing range aforesaid, being the commencing point:

And I do, with the advice aforesaid, further direct and appoint, that the aforesaid Circuit Court, within the said Northern Circuit District hereinbefore described, shall be holden at Castlemaine at the confluence of the creeks known as Barker's Creek and Forest Creek, in the said Circuit District, on the Ninth day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two; and on the ninth day of February; the ninth day of April; the ninth day of June; the ninth day of April; the ninth day of October; and the ninth day of December, in every year following, until otherwise ordered.

7. The above substitutions are not to be made except on the requisitions of the officer authorised to draw the several rations.

8. Vegetables to be supplied in reasonable proportions of potatoes, greens, pumpkins, onions,

9. The supplies for road parties and surveying parties are to be delivered at the nearest fixed stations to the places where the party may be employed, on the requisition of the officer in charge; and in case the whole ration of forage be not required or delivered, each of the species to be reckoned as the portion of the ration undermentioned:-The maize or barley 4-12-the hay 5-12-the bran 2-12-the straw 1-12.

10. The supplies (not specified in the preceeding paragraphs) are to be delivered direct to the parties or establishment entitled thereto, on the written order of the person duly authorised for

the purpose.

11. Provisions and forage, when required by rations, according to the scales under their respective heads, the tenders are to express the price per ration only.

13. In the event of a difference of opinion between the contractor and the party receiving the supplies, as to the quality, the same is to be decided, in cases where the article is not of a perishable nature, by a Board of Survey according to the practice of the service. But in country districts, where a Board of Survey cannot be conveniently assembled, the party objecting will name one person as arbitrator, the contractor or his agent another, and these two will, (previously to any other proceeding on their part) concur in naming a third, as umpire, who in the event of the arbitrators not agreeing in opinion, will be called upon for his decision, which shall be final.

14. If the board, arbitrators, or umpire shall decide that the article is not of proper quality, it must be immediately replaced by the contractor, failing of which it will be procured by the department requiring it, and the expense charged
