PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Charles Joseph La Trobe, Esquire, Lieutenant Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation under my Hand and the Seal of the said Colony, bearing date at Melbourne the twenty-first day of June last, I did announce and proclaim that the Legislative Council of the said Colony should assemble for the despatch of business on the second day of August next: And whereas it is expedient further to prorogue the same, Now therefore I, the Lieutenant Governor aforesaid, by virtue of the power and authority in that behalf in me vested, do hereby further prorogue the said Legislative Council to Tuesday, the thirtieth day of August next: And I do hereby further announce and proclaim that the said Legislative Council shall assemble for the despatch of business on the aforesaid thirtieth day of August next, at twelve o'clock at noon, in the Council Chamber situate in Bourke-street in the City of Melbourne, and the Members of the said Legislative Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the said Colony, at Melbourne, in the said Colony, this twentieth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-three, and in the seventeenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
