ELTHAM ROAD DISTRICT.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Major-General MACARTHUR, the Senior Military Officer in Command of Her Majesty's Land Forces in the Colony of Victoria, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Lieutenant Governor and Legislative Council of the Colony of Victoria, passed in the sixteenth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making and improving Roads in the Colony of Victoria," it was amongst other things enacted that it should be lawful for the Lieutenant Governor from time to time, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, to proclaim and declare any such portion of the said Colony as to him should seem meet, as and to be a Road District for the purposes in the said Act contained, and also to define the boundaries of every Road District thereby proclaimed and declared, and to give a specific name or designation to every such Road District: Now therefore I, Major-General Macarthur, the Senior Military Officer and Officer administering the Government of Victoria, in pursuance of the power so vested in me by the said Act, and of every other power and authority enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the undermentioned portion of the said Colony shall be a Road District, that is to say:—Commencing at the bridge on the Lower Plenty River near the township of Eltham, thence southerly by that river to its junction with the river Yarra Yarra, thence by the Yarra Yarra to its source, thence along the eastern and northern boundaries of the county of Evelyn to the source of Diamond Creek, thence along the source of that creek to its confluence with the Back Creek, thence by the Back Creek to the north-east corner of portion v. parish of Nillumbik, thence south by the east boundary line of portions v. iv. iii. ii. i. xvii. and part of portion x. to the road to the Caledonian diggings, thence westerly by that road to the south boundary of portion E, thence due east to the Plenty River, and thence by that river to the commencing point: And I do hereby further proclaim and declare that the specific name or designation of such Road District shall be "The Eltham Road District."

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this twenty-fourth day of September, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, and in the twentieth year of Her Majesty's Reign.

LOCAL COURT REGULATIONS.

HEPBURN.

REGULATIONS made by the Local Court of the District of HEBURN:—

XI. Baling claims to be compulsory.—All parties shall be compelled to bale the water from their claims when it can be proved that the accumulation is injurious to the adjoining miners. A notice of six hours to be given to the party or parties so neglecting prior to complaint being made to the Warden. This regulation to apply both to day and night working.

XII. Protection to be afforded to proposed course of race.—When a sluicing claim is granted by the Warden, protection shall be afforded to the proposed course of the race to be cut to such claim, provided the said course be defined by substantial pegs placed at intervals of (20) twenty yards.

The foregoing Regulations, Nos. XI. and XII., have been assented to by His Excellency the Officer administering the Government, with the advice of the Executive Council.

LOCAL COURT REGULATIONS.

BEECHWORTH.

REGULATIONS made by the Local Court of the District of BEECHWORTH:—

XXXV. Four months allowed to procure quartz crushing machinery. Upon quartz reefs four months may be allowed, on application, for the purpose of procuring machinery, provided that at least one man holding a Miner's Right be continued on the claim from the date of registration.

XXXVI. Extent of claim on the Boundary and Wooragay Creeks.—The extent of claim on the Boundary and Wooragay Creeks shall be limited to eighty yards in length, and in no case to exceed one hundred yards in breadth, to each claim holder, it being imperative upon such holder to have at least eight men holding Miner's Rights employed upon such claim. Where the breadth of the creek may be less than one hundred yards the breadth of claim to be taken as extending from bank to bank.

XXXVII. Extent of surfacing claim on Woolshed and Reid's Creeks.—The extent of surfacing claim upon the Woolshed and Reid's Creeks for sluicing purposes shall be to each claim holder:—On worked ground, twenty yards in breadth by one hundred yards back measurement; On new ground, the same extent of claim may be allowed, but the sinking not to exceed five feet in depth, it being imperative upon the holders of claims to keep at least three men having Miner's Rights constantly employed upon such claims.

XXXVIII. Tail races.—All parties holding bed claims shall be bound to cut and maintain an efficient tail race through or past their respective claims.

XXXIX. Water rights reserved during dry weather.—All water rights granted from springs or other sources liable to become dry in summer shall not be forfeited in consequence of the owners of such rights working upon other claims or with other water, during the time the race is dry or has not sufficient water for its purpose.

The foregoing Regulations, Nos. XXXV. to XXXIX., have been assented to by His Excellency the Officer administering the Government, with the advice of the Executive Council.

MUNICIPALITY OF WILLIAMSTOWN.

BYE-LAW No. 10.—To ORDER AND REGULATE THE FORMATION OF ANY PRIVATE CROSSING OR CROSSINGS OVER OR THROUGH ANY PUBLIC FOOTPATH OR WATERCOURSE WHERE THE CONVENIENCE AND USE OF SUCH CROSSING OR CROSSINGS SHALL BE COMMON TO TWO OR MORE OWNERS OR OCCUPIERS.

WHEREAS for the better protection of the public footpaths and watercourses of this Municipality it is expedient and necessary that where access or approach for beasts of burden or wheeled vehicles is required to any private street, private right-of-way, or by-lane, and where such access or approach can be obtained only by such beasts of burden or wheeled vehicles or any of them being ridden or driven, or caused to be ridden or driven over, across, or through any public footpath or watercourse; to compel the several owners or occupiers of land or premises situate in or abutting on any such private street, private right-of-way or by-lane to unite in defraying the cost of constructing every such crossing or crossings thereto as may be necessary for the purposes required over or through any such public footpath or watercourse, whereby no such footpath or watercourse shall receive any damage.

Be it therefore ordered and enacted by the Council of the Municipal District of Williamstown that from and after the date of this Bye-Law receiving the assent of His Excellency the Officer administering the Government, pursuant to 18th Victoria, No. 15, sec. 33, &c. That where access or approach for beasts of burden or wheeled vehicles is required to any private street, private right-of-way or by-lane; and where such access or approach can be obtained only by such beasts of burden or wheeled vehicles, or any of them, being ridden or driven, or caused to be ridden or driven over, through, or across any public footpath or watercourse, it shall be lawful for the said Council to construct over, through, or across such footpath or watercourse every such crossing or crossings as shall be necessary for the purposes required and whereby such footpath or watercourse shall not receive any damage; and it shall be lawful for the said Council to charge a proportion of the cost of constructing any such crossing or crossings upon every owner or occupier of land or premises situate in or abutting on any such private street, private right-of-way, or by-lane to which any such crossing or crossings shall have been made.

And be it further ordered and enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall be lawful for the said Council to apportion and charge the cost of constructing any such crossing or crossings upon every such owner or occupier as aforesaid in a ratio corresponding with the amount in which every such owner or occupier is assessed and rated in the Rate Book of the said Council for the then current municipal year, in respect of any property in houses and land which belongs to or is in the occupation of any such owner or occupier, and which is situate in or abutting on any such private street, private right-of-way, or by-lane to which every such crossing or crossings shall have been made; and should any such owner or occupier refuse or neglect to pay his or her proportion as aforesaid of the cost of constructing any such crossing or crossings for more than fourteen days, after the same has been demanded of him or her by or on behalf of the said Council, every such owner or occupier shall, on conviction thereof before any two or more of the Justices of the Peace for the said district, forfeit and pay for every such refusal, neglect, or offence a sum or penalty not exceeding Ten Pounds.

And be it further ordered and enacted, that every such crossing or crossings as aforesaid shall be made and maintained in the form and manner and of the materials described in the Schedule A annexed unto Bye-Law, No. 2, of this Council.

Justices of the Peace forfeit and pay for every such offence a fine not exceeding ten pounds: And be it further ordered and enacted, that an announcement according to the said Municipal Act, 18 Vict. No. 15, shall be deemed an appointment of such public depot for night soil, manure, offal, or other offensive refuse.
