FURTHER PROROGATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Major-General MACARTHUR, the Senior Military Officer in Command of Her Majesty's Land Forces in the Colony of Victoria, &c., &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS the Legislative Council of the Colony of Victoria has been and now stands prorogued to Tuesday, the third day of the ensuing month of June, and it is deemed expedient further to prorogue the said Council: Now therefore I, Major-General MACARTHUR, the Senior Military Officer and Officer administering the Government of the said Colony, with the advice of the Executive Council, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Legislative Council to Tuesday, the first day of July now next ensuing.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this thirtieth day of May, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, and in the nineteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
