QUARANTINE-RIO JANEIRO.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Major-General Macartuun, the Senior Military Officer in Command of Her Majesty's Land Forces in the Colony of Victoria, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS it has been represented to the Government that Asiatic Cholera has appeared on board of a vessel recently arrived from the Port of Rio Janeiro: Now therefore I, Major-General Macarrium, the Senior Military Officer and Officer administering the Government of the Colony of Victoria, in pursuance of the power in me vested, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and direct that all ships and vessels arriving in this Colony from the said Port of Rio Janeiro with Cholera on board, or having had any case of Cholera on board previous to the arrival thereof in this Colony from the said Port, and the crews and passengers of such ships and vessels, sail in every case perform Quarantine for a period of not less than thirty clear days after the convalescence of the last case of Cholera; and if no case of Cholera shall have appeared on board of such ships and vessels, nevertheless such ships and vessels, and the crews and passengers on board thereof, shall perform Quarantine for a period of three clear days.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this fourth day of June, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, and in the nineteeth year of Her Majesty's Reign.

QUARANTINE OF THE OCEAN MONARCH.

CASES of Asiatic Chelera, several of which have proved fatal, having occurred on beard of the ship Ocean Monarch during her passage from Rio Janeiro to Port Phillip, His Excellency the Officer administering the Government, with the advice of the Executive Council, under the authority of the Acts of the Governor and Legislative Council of New South Wales, 3 William IV., 1, and 5 Victoria, No. 12, has placed the said ship, and the crew and passengers thereof under Quarantine for a period of thirty days from the convalescence of the last case of Cholera, and all persons are hereby required to take notice thereof accordingly.

The boundaries of the Quarantine Station, at Point Nepean, are specified in a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of November, 1852.
