WHEREAS the Legislative Council of the Colony of Victoria has been and now stands prorogued to Tuesday, the First day of the ensuing month of July, and it is deemed expedient further to prorogue the said Council: Now therefore I; Major-In the Executive Council, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested, do by this my Proclamation further prerogne the said Legislative Council to Priday, the First day of August now next ensuing.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this Twenty-fourth day of June, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, and in the twentieth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
