PREVENTION OF CONTAGIOUS DISEASE.

ORDER OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, Melbourne, the 12th day of October, 1857.

PRESENT:

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the eighteenth year of Her present Majesty, intituled "An Act for promoting Public Health in Populous Places in the "Colony of Victoria," it is enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, by orders to be by him from time to time made, to direct that the provisions thereinafter contained for the prevention of epidemic, endemic, and contagious diseases, be put in force in the colony, or in such parts thereof, or in such places therein, as in such orders respectively may be expressed, and in like manner to rescind such orders:

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order direct that the provisions contained in the twenty-third and subsequent clauses of the said Act, for the prevention of epidemic, endemic, and contagious diseases, be put in force in the colony.

And the Honorable William Clark Haines, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
