QUARANTINE OF THE "OCEAN CHIEF."

SEVERAL cases of small-pox having occurred on board of the ship *Ocean Chief*, during her passage from Liverpool to Port Phillip, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has placed the said ship, and the crew and passengers thereof, under quarantine, for a period of fourteen clear days from the convalescence of the last case of small-pox; and all persons are hereby required to take notice thereof accordingly.

The boundaries of the Quarantine Station, at Point Nepean, are specified in a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of November, 1852.
