NOTICE TO RETURNING OFFICERS OF ELECTORAL PROVINCES AND
DISTRICTS.

THE attention of the Returning Officers of the several Electoral Provinces and Districts is drawn to the clause of "*The Election Proceedings Regulation Act of 1856*" (19 Victoria No. 11, section 10), wherein it is directed as follows:—

"Once in every year in the month of July the Returning Officer of every province and district shall appoint a fit and proper person to be an election officer to be called '*Election Auditor*' to act at any election or elections for and during the year then next ensuing and until another appointment of election auditor shall be made and such Returning Officer shall in such way as he shall think best give public notice of such appointment in such province or district" &c.
