SPECIAL REVISION COURTS FOR PROVINCES.

At the Government House, Melbourne, the eighteenth day of January, 1858.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the twenty-first year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled "*An Act to extend the Right of Voting and to provide for the Registration of Parliamentary Electors.*" it was amongst other things enacted that the lists of voters for every province, district, or division should be revised by the several courts of petty sessions in such province, district, or division respectively, by such court of petty sessions in any adjacent province, district, or division as the Governor, with the advice aforesaid, should direct; and every Order by which any such direction should be made should be published in the *Government Gazette*, and a copy thereof should be transmitted to the registrars of every such province and district respectively: And whereas there are no existing courts of petty sessions in the several divisions specified in the second column of the schedule hereunto annexed:
