QUARANTINE OF THE "TORNADO."

THE existence of small-pox on board of the vessel *Tornado*, recently arrived from Liverpool, having been reported to the Government, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has ordered the said vessel, and the crew and passengers on board thereof, to be placed in quarantine, at the Quarantine Station at Point Nepean; and all persons are hereby required to take notice accordingly.

The boundaries of the Quarantine Station at Point Nepean are specified in a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of November, 1852.
