QUARANTINE OF THE "MORNING LIGHT."

THE existence of small-pox among the crew of the ship Morning Light, recently arrived in Port Phillip Bay from Liverpool, having been reported to the Government, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has ordered the said vessel and the crew thereof to be detained in quarantine at the Quarantine Station at Point Nepean, until measures shall have been taken to prevent the spread of the disease; and all persons are hereby required to take notice accordingly.

The boundaries of the Quarantine Station, at Point Nepean aforesaid, are specified in a Proclamation bearing date the 23rd day of November, 1852.
