POLLING PLACES FOR THE MINING DISTRICTS OF SANDHURST AND MARYBOROUGH.

At the Government House, Melbourne, the twenty-second day of February, 1859.

PRESENT :
His Excellency the Governor
Mr. O'Shanassy Mr. Ireland
Mr. Chapman

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the twenty-first year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for amending the Laws relative to the Gold Fields*, it is enacted that a poll shall be taken for the election of members for each division of every mining district, at such places within such division as the Governor in Council shall from time to time direct, and every poll shall commence at Nine o'clock in the forenoon, and close at Five o'clock in the afternoon, and shall be taken in such buildings as the returning officer shall select: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order direct, that in lieu of all places previously appointed for taking the poll at elections at the several divisions of the mining districts of Sandhurst and Maryborough, the poll shall be taken for the said elections at the several places named in the last column of the schedule hereunto annexed, within and for the divisions of the said mining districts respectively set opposite thereto in the second column of the same schedule, that is to say:—
