POSTPONEMENT OF DATES UNDER THE REGISTRATION ACT 22 VICTORIA No. 81.

At the Government House, Melbourne, the tenth day of March, 1859.

PRESENT:

The Honorable Major-General Macarthur, C.B. Mr. O'Shanassy Mr. Harker

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the twenty-second year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, An Act to amend the Law relating to the Registration of Parliamentary Electors, it is amongst other things enacted, that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to extend the time mentioned in the said Act as the time at which any act, matter, or thing is required to be done in reference to the preparation and completion of the Electoral Rolls for the year One thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, provided that no such extension shall exceed the period of two calendar months: And whereas none of the Electoral Lists have yet been prepared, and the time appointed by law for such preparation has passed: Now therefore the Honorable Major-General Macarthur, presiding in the place and stead of His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order extend the times mentioned in the said Act as the times at which the several acts, matters and things specified in the first column of the Schedule hereunto annexed are required to be done in reference to the preparation and completion of the Electoral Rolls for the year One thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine; and with the advice aforesaid, doth hereby appoint such several acts, matters and things to be done at the respective times mentioned in the fourth column of the same Schedule, in lieu of the times mentioned in the third column thereof, that is to say:
