#### DIVISIONS OF ELECTORAL DISTRICTS.

At the Government House, Melbourne, the 21st day of March, 1859.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the twenty-second year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, An Act to amend the Law relating to the Registration of Parliamentary Electors, it is amongst other things enacted, that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to divide, for the purposes of the said Act, each electoral district into such and so many divisions, with such limits and boundaries, and to annul, alter, and amend such divisions, as to such Governor in Council may seem fit; and every Order by which any such division shall be made, annulled, or altered, and any limits or boundaries as aforesaid shall be defined or altered, shall be forthwith published in the Government Gazette; and it is further enacted that the electoral districts mentioned in the said Act shall be and be deemed to be the electoral districts as described in and by the Act 22 Victoria number LXIV. Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order divide, for the purposes of the above recited Act, the several electoral districts mentioned in the first column of the schedule hereunto annexed into the divisions respectively mentioned in the second column of the same schedule opposite to the names of such divisions shall be the limits and boundaries mentioned in the third column of the same schedule opposite to the names of such divisions respectively, that is to say:—
