FURTHER PROROGATION OF PARLIAMENT.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency SIR HENRY BARKLY, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS the present Parliament has been and now stands prorogued to Thursday, the Thirty-first day of March instant : And whereas it is deemed expedient further to prorogue the said Parliament : Now therefore I, Sir Henry Barkly, the Governor of Victoria, do hereby further prorogue the said Parliament until Wednesday, the Fourth day of May in the present year.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this Thirtieth day of March, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, and in the twenty-second year of Her Majesty's Reign.
