PROPOSED APPROPRIATION OF CROWN
LANDS FOR COMMONS.

IN accordance with the Act of Parliament 24 Victoria No. 117, it is hereby notified that it is the intention of the Governor to appropriate the lands hereinafter described for the purpose of Town Commons and God's Fields Commons, viz.:—

GOLD FIELDS COMMONS.

MARYBOROUGH MINING DISTRICT.

MOLIAGUL, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH OF MOLIAGUL.
Commencing at the intersection of the west side of the Moliagul and Dunolly road with the south boundary of the township; thence by said road south-easterly 50 chains, more or less; thence north 100 chains, more or less; thence east 80 chains, more or less, to west boundary of said township; thence north by said west boundary to north-west angle of said township; thence east by north boundary of said township to north-east angle of same; thence south by east boundary of said township to south-east angle of same; thence west by south boundary of said township to the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 2000 acres.

INGLEWOOD, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH UNNAMED.

Commencing at a point on the west bank of the River Loddon, bearing west from the south-west angle of section 19 (on opposite bank) of the parish of Yurrayne; thence west 9 miles 60 chains; thence south six miles to the south-east angle of Glenalbyn pre-emptive section; thence east 9 miles 10 chains to the River Loddon; thence by that river downwards to the commencing point; as shown upon the plan in Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 37,296 acres.

WEDDERBURN, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH UNNAMED.

Commencing at the south-east angle of the township of Wedderburne; thence north by east boundary of said township to north-east angle of same; thence west by north boundary of said township to north-west angle of same; thence south along west boundary of said township 23 chains, more or less; thence west 120 chains, more or less; thence south 180 chains, more or less; thence east 157 chains, more or less, to road from Wedderburne to Kingower; thence northerly by said road to its intersection with south boundary of township of Wedderburne; thence east by south boundary of said township to the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 4188 acres.

KINGOWER, COUNTY UNNAMED.

Commencing at the north-west angle of the township of Kooyora; thence east 200 chains, more or less, to the west boundary of Glenalbyn section; thence to the south-west angle thereof; thence along the south boundary thereof and a line east 132 chains, more or less; thence south 268 chains, more or less; thence west 208 chains, more or less; thence north 68 chains, more or less, to the road from Moliagul to Kooyora;

thence by that road north-easterly and north-westerly to the east side of the town of Kooyora; thence by the town boundary south to the south-east angle of township; thence by the south and west boundaries of the township to the commencing point. Approximate area for common, after deducting sold and appropriated lands, 5800.

TARNAGULLA, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH UNNAMED.

Commencing at the north-west angle of Tarnagulla township; thence east 3 miles; thence south 110 chains; thence west 3 miles to the south-west angle of the said township; thence north by the west boundary of said township to the commencing point; as shown upon the plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 2540 acres.

COCHRANE'S DIGGINGS, COUNTY AND PARISH UNNAMED.

Commencing at a point on the east side of the road from Archdale pre-emptive section to Moliagul 75 chains north of said section; thence east 90 chains; thence north 270 chains to intersection of said road; thence south-westerly and southerly by said road to the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 1800 acres.

BACK CREEK, COUNTY OF TALBOT, PARISH OF AMHERST.

Commencing at the south-west angle of allotment 22, section 8, parish of Amherst; thence south 252 chains, more or less; thence east 312 chains, more or less, to Mount Greenock Creek; thence along that creek (being the parish boundary) north-easterly 100 chains, more or less; again along the parish boundary north 60 chains, more or less; thence north-westerly 20 chains, more or less; thence north along the parish boundary 56 chains, more or less; thence west 40 chains, more or less; thence north 88 chains, more or less, to the north-east angle of allotment 6, section 5, parish of Amherst; thence west 80 chains, more or less, to the north-west angle of allotment 1, section 5, same parish; thence south 116 chains, more or less; thence west 80 chains, more or less; thence north 72 chains, more or less, to a point 1 chain south of the south-east angle of allotment 45, section 8, parish of Amherst; thence west 1 chain south of and parallel to the south boundaries of allotments 45, 46, 47, 43, 28, and 22 of section 8, 144 chains, more or less, to the south-west angle of allotment 22, section 8, the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 8300 acres.

MCCALLUM'S CREEK, COUNTY OF TALBOT, PARISH OF CRAIGIE.

Commencing at the junction of a creek with the Mount Greenock Creek east of allotment 19 section 2, parish of Craigie; thence north by the Mount Greenock Creek 60 chains, more or less, to intersection with a road from Carisbrook towards Mount Greenock; thence east by said road 10 chains, more or less; thence northerly by said road 80 chains, more or less, to the south boundary of a reservoir; thence by said boundary east 50 chains, more or less; thence south 256 chains, more or less; thence west 120 chains, more or less, to the above-mentioned road; thence northerly by said road to its intersection with the Mount Greenock Creek 100 chains, more or less; thence by said creek to the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 2000 acres.

LAMPLOUGH, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH OF YALONG, AND UNNAMED.

Commencing at the south-east angle of the parish of Avoca; thence east 308 chains, more or less; thence north 320 chains, more or less; thence west 308 chains, more or less, to the eastern boundary of the parish of Avoca; thence by said boundary south to the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 9000 acres.

GLENLOGIE.

Commencing at a point on the Avoca River near its junction with a creek intersected by the main road from Elmhurst to Lamplough; thence by aforesaid creek to a point due east of the north-western angle of the township of Glenlogie; thence by northern boundary of township to said angle; thence by western boundary to south-west angle; thence by a line west 80 chains, more or less; thence by a line south 40 chains, more or less; thence by a line east, crossing the Avoca River, 275 chains, more or less; thence by a line bearing about 20° west 200 chains, more or less, to the Avoca River; and by that river southerly to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate available area 2820 acres.

St. ARNAUD.

Commencing at a point being the south-east angle of township of St. Arnaud; thence north 100 chains, more or less; thence west 100 chains, more or less; thence north 80 chains, more or less; thence west 120 chains, more or less; thence south 80 chains, more or less; thence by a line bearing south 52 degrees east, more or less, to the south-west angle of township of St. Arnaud, and by its southern boundary line to the commencing point; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate available area for common 2500 acres.

SANDHURST MINING DISTRICT.

WARANGA.

Commencing at the north-east corner of the township of Rushworth; thence by the eastern boundary and by a straight line southerly to the north-east corner of the township of Whiroo; thence along the eastern, southern, and western boundaries of the said township, and a straight line northerly to the south-west angle of the township of Rushworth; thence along the western and northern boundaries of the said township to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Approximate area for common, after deducting sold and appropriated lands, about 3300 acres.

BALLAARAT MINING DISTRICT.

CARNHAM.

Commencing at the south-east angle of the township reserve; thence north 80 chains, more or less; thence west 80 chains, more or less; thence south 80 chains, more or less; thence west 48 chains, more or less; thence by the east side of Russell and Co.'s pre-emptive section and a line south 160 chains, more or less; thence east 84 chains, more or less; thence north 160 chains, more or less; thence west 40 chains, more or less, to the commencing point; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate available area for common 2000 acres.

SMYTHSDALE, COUNTY OF GRENVILLE.

Commencing at the south-west angle of the township reserve of Smythsdale; thence by its southern boundary to the south-east angle; thence by a line south 20 chains; thence by a line east 137 chains; thence by a line north 220 chains; thence by a line west and the southern boundary of McLachlan's pre-emptive right 205 chains; thence by a line south to northern boundary of Smythsdale town reserve 80 chains; thence by the northern boundary of same to north-west angle 24 chains (all distances more or less); and thence by the western boundary of township to the commencing point; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 5000 acres.

LINTON'S AND BROWN'S, COUNTY OF GRENVILLE.

Commencing at the south-west corner at the north-east angle of allotment 18 in the parish of Argyle; bounded on the west by a line bearing north 2 miles, more or less; thence east 3 miles 20 chains, more or less, to the east side of Woody Yalook Creek; thence by that creek to the north-east corner of J. Browne's pre-emptive right; thence west by the north boundary of said pre-emptive right; thence by the west boundary of the said pre-emptive right; thence by the south boundary of said pre-emptive right to the north-west corner of another pre-emptive right belonging to the said J. Browne; thence by the west boundary of the last pre-emptive right; thence by its south boundary to the said creek; thence by that creek to Baird's pre-emptive right; and thence by the north boundary of that pre-emptive right and a line bearing west 3 miles 16 chains, more or less, to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area 3540 acres for common.

STEIGLITZ, COUNTY OF GRANT.

Commencing at the south-east corner, bearing east 2 miles 60 chains, more or less, from the north-west corner of allotment 47, in the parish of Anakie; bounded on the south by a line bearing west 2 miles, more or less; thence north 1 mile 62 chains, more or less; thence east 2 miles, more or less; and thence 1 mile 62 chains to the point of commencement; as shown on plan de-

posited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area 2300 acres for common.

CRESWICK, COUNTY OF TALBOT, PARISH OF CRESWICK.

Commencing at the south-west angle of the municipal boundary line of Creswick, and bounded on the west by a line bearing north 176 chains, more or less; on the north by a line bearing east 280 chains, more or less; on the east by a line bearing south 176 chains, more or less, and thence east 80 chains, more or less; thence south 160 chains, more or less; on the south by a line bearing west 200 chains, more or less; thence north 160 chains, more or less; and thence west 152 chains, more or less, to the commencing point; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting all the sold or appropriated Crown lands. Area for common about 8000 acres.

BLACKWOOD, COUNTY OF BOURKE, PARISH OF BLACKWOOD.

Commencing at the south-east angle of the township reserve of Blackwood, and bounded on the south by a line bearing west 120 chains, more or less; thence north 40 chains, more or less; thence west 80 chains, more or less; thence north 80 chains, more or less; thence east 200 chains, more or less; thence south 120 chains, more or less, to the commencing point; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting all sold and appropriated land. Approximate area for common 2060 acres.

ARARAT MINING DISTRICT.

ARMSTRONG'S DIGGINGS, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH UNNAMED.

Commencing at a point on the west side of the road from Great Western to Ararat, 10 chains south-easterly from the Junction Inn, on the same road; thence west 102 chains; thence north 120 chains; thence east 120 chains; thence south 120 chains; thence west 18 chains to the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 1440 acres.

CAMPBELL'S DIGGINGS.

Commencing at the north-west angle of allotment 10, section 7, in the parish of Lexington; thence by a line west 160 chains, more or less; thence by a line south 120 chains, more or less; thence by a line east 160 chains, more or less; thence by a line north 120 chains, more or less, to the commencing point; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Approximate available area for common 1920 acres.

GREAT WESTERN, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH UNNAMED.

Commencing at the north-west angle of the township of Great Western; thence south 80 chains; thence east 80 chains; thence north 80 chains; thence west 80 chains to the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 550 acres.

STAWELL, COUNTY AND PARISH UNNAMED.

Portion A: Commencing at a point being the south-east angle of the township reserve of Stawell, and bounded on the south by a line bearing west 80 chains, more or less; thence by a line bearing southerly 84 chains, more or less; thence by a line bearing west 120 chains, more or less; on the west by a line bearing north 100 chains, more or less; on the north by a line bearing east 267 chains 50 links, more or less; thence north 124 chains 42 links, more or less; thence east 124 chains 42 links, more or less; thence south 124 chains 21 links, more or less; thence west 124 chains 42 links, more or less; thence south 80 chains, more or less, to the commencing point.

Portion B: Commencing at the south-east angle of portion B, bearing north about 31° west 240 chains, more or less, from the north-west angle of the town reserve of Stawell; thence by a line north 80 chains, more or less; thence by a line west 187 chains 50 links, more or less; thence by a line south 80 chains, more or less; thence by a line east 187 chains 50 links, more or less, to the commencing point; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common about 6448 acres.

CROWLANDS, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH UNNAMED.

Commencing at a point, 340 chains, more or less, north of the north-west angle of the township of Crowlands; thence north-westerly 200 chains, more or less; thence north-easterly by a line at right angles to former, 120 chains, more or less; thence south-easterly by a line at right angles with the preceding, 240 chains, more or less; thence south-westerly by a line at right angles with the preceding, 120 chains, more or less; thence by a line being continuation of the first mentioned boundary, 40 chains, more or less, to the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 2850 acres.

CROWLANDS, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISHES OF CROWLANDS AND EVERSLEY.

Commencing at the north-east angle of the township of Crowlands; thence north 75 chains, more or less; thence east 160 chains, more or less; thence south 160 chains, more or less; thence west 80 chains, more or less; thence north 80 chains, more or less; thence west 75 chains, more or less, to the commencing point; together with the township of Crowlands; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above described areas all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 2800 acres.

RAGLAN AND BEAUFORT, COUNTY OF RIFTON, ADJOINING THE TOWNSHIP OF BEAUFORT.

Commencing at the north-east angle of the police paddock at Beaufort, and bounded on the south by a road bearing westerly to the boundary line of Langi Kal-kal run; thence on the west by the said boundary line of Langi Kal-kal run bearing northerly

about 3 miles, more or less; thence on the north by a line bearing east 244 chains, more or less; thence on the east by a line bearing south 240 chains, more or less, to the commencing point; also, all the unappropriated and unsold crown lands in the townships of Raglan and Beaufort; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Approximate area for common about 7000 acres.

CASTLEMAINE MINING DISTRICT.

YANDOIT, COUNTY OF BOURKE.

Commencing at a point on the Jim Crow Creek due west of north-west angle of allotment 1, section 10, parish of Yandoit; thence by a line east to said angle; thence by the northern boundaries of lots 1 and 2 of section 10 to a road; thence by the eastern side of that road north-easterly to the south-west angle of section 3; thence by the western boundaries of same to south-west angle of section 2; thence by western boundaries of same to south boundary of Kennedy's pre-emptive section; thence by southern and western boundaries of same to a point on the western boundary due east of the north-east angle of allotment 1, section 1, of lots surveyed on Jim Crow Creek in parish of Yandoit; and thence southerly by the Jim Crow Creek to point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Approximate area for common about 3000 acres.

FRYERS, COUNTY OF TALBOT, PARISHES OF GUILDFORD, FRYERS, AND ELPHINSTONE.

Commencing at the north-west angle of the parish of Guildford; thence by a line south to the River Loddon; thence along the River Loddon westerly to the north-west angle of Kennedy's pre-emptive right; thence by the west and south boundaries of Kennedy's pre-emptive right and a line bearing east, being a prolongation of the south boundary of the parish of Guildford following said line until it intersects the west boundary of the parish of Drummond; thence by part of the west boundary of the parish of Drummond, bearing north to the south-west angle of the parish of Elphinstone; thence by the south boundary of the parish of Elphinstone, bearing east to the Coliban River; thence by the Coliban River north-westerly to the north-east angle of allotment 1 section 8, parish of Elphinstone; thence by the north boundary and a line bearing west to the commencing point; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above-described area all sold and appropriated land. Approximate available area for common 13,000 acres.

ST. ANDREW'S, COUNTY OF EVELYN, PARISH UNNAMED.

Commencing at the north-east angle of the town reserve of Queenstown; thence by the east side of that reserve and a line bearing south 9 degrees east 235 chains, more or less; thence by a line bearing south 31 degrees west 190 chains, more or less, to the road leading to Queenstown; thence by that road north-easterly to its intersection with the south side of the town reserve; thence by the south side of the township to its south-west angle; thence by the west and north boundaries of the township to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Approximate area for common about 2500 acres.

ANDERSON'S CREEK, COUNTY OF EVELYN, PARISH OF WARRANDYTE.

Commencing at the north-west angle of the township of Warrandyte; bounded on the west by the west boundary of the township and a line bearing south 105 chains; thence on the south by the south boundaries of sections 2 and 16, parish of Warrandyte, bearing east 160 chains; thence by the east boundary of section 16 bearing north 80 chains; thence by the north boundary of section 16 bearing west 80 chains; thence by the east boundary of the town reserve bearing north 62 chains to the Yarra Yarra River; thence by the Yarra Yarra River south-westerly to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 1690 acres.

BEECHWORTH MINING DISTRICT.

WOOLSHED, BEECHWORTH DISTRICT, COUNTY UNNAMED.

Commencing at the junction of Graveyard Creek and Spring Creek; thence by a line west 2 miles 12 chains, more or less; thence by lines north and the western side of section A, Woolshed, 1½ miles, more or less; thence by a line east 1½ miles, more or less, to Spring Creek; thence by Spring Creek south-easterly to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from above-described area all sold and appropriated land. Approximate area for common 1725 acres.

SNAKE VALLEY, COUNTY UNNAMED.

Commencing at a point bearing north about 3 chains from the north angle of Snake Valley reservoir; thence east 152 chains, more or less; thence north 168 chains, more or less; thence west 230 chains, more or less; thence south 168 chains, more or less; thence east 78 chains, more or less, to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office. Deducting all sold lands from above-described area. Approximate area for common 3696 acres.

YACKANDANDAH, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH OF YACKANDANDAH.

Commencing at a point on the west side of the road leading from Yackandandah to Albury, about 2 chains north of the north angle of section F suburbs, Yackandandah; thence west 2½ miles, more or less; thence south 2½ miles, more or less; thence east 5½ miles, more or less; thence north 2½ miles, more or less; thence west 2½ miles, more or less, to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office. Deducting from above-described area all sold and appropriated land. Approximate area for common 7528 acres.

OMEQ, COUNTY UNNAMED, MURRAY DISTRICT.

Commencing at a point on the Mitta-mitta River, half a mile east of the junction of Livingstone Creek with the Mitta-mitta River; thence by a line 4 miles southerly, distant half a mile from and parallel to the Livingstone Creek; thence by a line westerly one mile crossing the Livingstone Creek; thence northerly half a mile distant from and parallel to the west side of Livingstone Creek 4 miles to the Mitta-mitta River; thence by the Mitta-mitta River easterly to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Approximate area for common 2560 acres.

INDIGO, COUNTY UNNAMED, MURRAY DISTRICT.

Commencing at the south side of a road 1 chain south from the south-west angle of suburban lot 1 at Chiltern; thence south 1 mile, more or less; thence east 130 chains, more or less; thence north 20 chains, more or less; thence east 160 chains, more or less; thence south 20 chains, more or less; thence east 152 chains, more or less; thence north 1½ miles, more or less; thence west 4 miles, more or less, to the north-west angle of the town reserve of Chiltern; thence crossing a road to the north-east angle of suburban section 6; thence south 60 chains, more or less; thence west 1 mile 36 chains, more or less, to the commencing point; as shown on plan deposited in Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Approximate area for common, after deducting all sold and appropriated lands, 5000 acres.

WAHGUNYAH, COUNTY UNNAMED.

Commencing at the south-west angle of section T, at Gooramadda; bounded on the west by a line bearing south 250 chains, more or less; thence east 360 chains, more or less; thence north 250 chains, more or less; thence west along sections D, L, M, U, and T, 360 chains, more or less, to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office Melbourne. Approximate area for common 9000 acres.

BUCKLAND.

Commencing at a point on the west boundary at the western angle of suburban section 1, Porcupinah; thence north by a line 120 chains, more or less; thence east by a line 240 chains, more or less; thence south by a line 238 chains, more or less; thence west 240 chains, more or less; thence north 168 chains, more or less, to the point of commencement; as shown on plan deposited in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Approximate area for common 7000 acres.

SWIFT'S CREEK, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH UNNAMED.

Commencing at a point on the River Tambo ½ mile south-westerly from the junction of Swift's Creek and the Tambo River; thence 4 miles northerly ½ a mile distant from and parallel to Swift's Creek; thence north-easterly one mile, crossing Swift's Creek; thence by a line south-easterly half a mile from and parallel to Swift's Creek 4 miles to the Tambo River; and by the Tambo River south-westerly to the commencing point. Approximate area for common 2560 acres.

TOWN COMMONS.

MARYBOROUGH MINING DISTRICT.

DUNOLLY, COUNTY UNNAMED, PARISH OF DUNOLLY.

Commencing at the south-east angle of the municipal boundary of Dunolly; thence south-westerly to the south angle of said boundary; thence north-westerly to the north-west angle of said boundary; thence north-easterly to the north angle of said boundary; thence south-easterly 250 chains, more or less, along said boundary; thence east 290 chains, more or less; thence south 290 chains, more or less; thence north-westerly 200 chains, more or less, to the commencing point; as shown on plan in the Crown Lands Office, Melbourne. Deducting from the above-described area all sold and appropriated lands. Approximate area for common 8244 acres.

MARYBOROUGH, COUNTY OF TALBOT, PARISH OF MARYBOROUGH.
