**LAND PROPOSED TO BE PERMANENTLY
RESERVED.**

IN compliance with the terms of the 4th section of the Act of Parliament 24 Victoria No. 117, it is hereby notified that it is intended permanently to reserve from sale the land hereinafter described for the purpose of extending the area of the reservoir for water in connection with the municipal district of Ararat, subject to the conditions that the municipal council of Ararat shall not interfere with the water-shed above the reservoir, and that compensation be made by the said municipal council to parties in legal occupation of the land required for the proposed reservoir at the date of this notification.

It is also hereby notified that the Governor in Council has, in the meantime, temporarily reserved such land from sale under the power in that behalf contained in the 3rd section of the said Act, and has also exempted the said land from mining operations within the meaning of the 4th section of the Gold Fields Act 21 Victoria No. 32.

DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND ABOVE REFERRED TO.—County of Ripon, parish of Ararat, Eleven acres two roods sixteen perches: Commencing at a point on the west side of Vincent street, bearing south 29 degrees 45 minutes west two chains one and a half links from the north-west angle of allotment 4 section 3, township of Ararat; bounded on the south by a line bearing west thirteen chains forty links; on the west by a line bearing north 8 chains 47 links; on the north by a line bearing east thirteen chains forty links; and on the east by a line being a prolongation of the west side of Vincent street, bearing south eight chains forty-seven links to the point of commencement.

CHEWTON.

The petitioners state their belief that Chewton, owing to its extent and the large amount of property there, is a suitable locality to be declared a municipality, the property held by themselves representing £100,000, or thereabouts.

That a municipal incorporation will tend much to the advancement and prosperity of the district, which, from the advantages it possesses, promises to be self-supporting.

That more than one hundred and fifty householders have affixed their signatures to the petition.

PETITION UNDER THE MUNICIPAL INSTITUTIONS ACT.

Kew.

IN pursuance of the Act of Council 18 Victoria No. 15, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has directed the publication of the substance and prayer of a petition addressed to His Excellency as hereinafter set forth, signed by one hundred and seventy-two householders resident at Kew, in the county of Bourke, praying for the erection of their locality into a municipal district.

WILLIAM NICHOLSON.

The petitioners state that they are all householders within the meaning of the Act 18 Victoria No. 15, are more than one hundred and fifty in number, and are all resident within an area of nine square miles, containing a population of more than three hundred householders.

That they are desirous that the village of Kew and its neighborhood should be constituted a municipal district, and governed by a local council.

They propose that the boundaries of the district shall be the following, viz.:—"Commencing in the centre of the Government road bounding portions 71, 72, 73, 74, and 75 of the parish Boroondara; on the south at the junction of that road with the River Yarra Yarra, and bearing east from the said commencing point along the centre of the said road to the end thereof, and thence further east along the centre of a private road to the centre of the Government road which bounds Elgar's Special Survey on the west; thence bearing north along the centre of the last-mentioned road to portion 52 of the said parish; thence bearing east fifty-links to the south-eastern corner of the said portion 52; thence bearing north along the said eastern boundary line of the said portion to the River Yarra Yarra; and thence by the River Yarra Yarra to the commencing point."

And the petitioners pray as follows:—

"Your petitioners therefore humbly pray your Excellency that the before-mentioned boundaries may be constituted the limits of the municipal district; that your Excellency will be pleased to constitute the same under the name of 'The Municipal District of Kew,' and also be pleased to issue the necessary proclamation for declaring it a municipality and defining the limits accordingly."

BYE-LAWS.

The following bye-laws made by the council have received the assent of His Excellency the Governor, viz. —

Bye-law No. 15. For making an assessment and levying a rate of One shilling in the pound.

Bye-law No. 16. For the appropriation of the first instalment of grant-in-aid for 1860.

ASSESSMENT.

The gross assessment for the current year amounted to £23,907, on which reductions were made at a court of appeal of £1342 10s., leaving a net amount of £22,564 10s.

ELECTION.

On the 8th of October Councillor Kersley tendered his resignation, in consequence of his departure for England, and on the 8th November following Councillor D. W. Virtue was elected without opposition to fill the vacant seat in the council.

FINANCE.

The debt of £461 9s. owing at the last half-yearly report to the Bank of Victoria has been paid with interest, and the council had on the 4th November a balance of £133 3s. 9d. in the London Chartered Bank.

The defalcations that appear in the accounts of the late rate collector, in consequence of his untimely decease, can only be explained by the circumstance of his having employed another person to collect rates who was not responsible to the council, and against whom the council is debarred from instituting legal proceedings.

The repayment of the debt to the bank, and the presentation of accounts of long standing for payment, has necessarily limited the expenditure on public works. The funds in hand, however, and the rates to be collected during the next half-year, will enable the council to show a larger amount expended on public works at the date of the next half-yearly report.

A rate of One shilling in the pound was struck on the 21st day of August, a portion of which for the first half-year has yet to be collected.

Owing to the small amount of rates collected during the last year, the first instalment of grant-in-aid from Government was only £592 12s. 3d., and the balance £221 6s. 5d. From the amount of rates collected, and to be collected during the current year, it is anticipated that the grant for next year will be more than doubled.
