THE DIVISIONS OF THE ELECTORAL DISTRICTS.

*At the Government House, Melbourne, the thirtieth day of July, 1860.*

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the twenty-second year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to amend the Law relating to the Registration of Parliamentary Electors*, it was amongst other things enacted that it should be lawful for the Governor in Council to divide, for the purposes of the said Act, each electoral district into such and so many divisions, with such limits and boundaries, and to annul, alter, and amend such divisions, as to such Governor in Council might seem fit; and every Order by which any such division should be made, annulled, or altered, and any limits or boundaries as aforesaid should be defined or altered, should be forthwith published in the *Government Gazette*; and it was further enacted that the electoral districts mentioned in the said Act should be and be deemed to be the electoral districts as described in and by the Act 22 Victoria number LXIV.: And whereas by two several Orders of the Governor in Council, made on the twenty-first day of March and the ninth day of May, in the year One thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, the said electoral districts were divided as therein mentioned; and it is deemed expedient to alter and amend certain of the divisions thereof: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order divide, for the purposes of the above recited Act, the several electoral districts mentioned or referred to in the first column of the schedule hereunto annexed, into the divisions respectively mentioned in the second column of the same schedule, and doth appoint that the limits and boundaries of such divisions shall be the limits and boundaries mentioned in the third column of the same schedule opposite to the names of such divisions respectively, that is to say:—

1. WEST MELBOURNE	1. St. Mary's ...	Bounded on the north by Victoria street; on the south-west by King street; on the south-east by Lonsdale street; and on the north-east by Elizabeth street.
	2. St. Patrick's ...	Bounded on the north-west by Lonsdale street; on the south-west by William street; on the south by the River Yarra; and on the north-east by Elizabeth street.
	3. Railway ...	Bounded on the north-east by King street; on the north by Victoria street (excluding the Benevolent Asylum Reserve) and a line west to the western boundary of the city; on the west by the said western boundary of the city; on the south-east by part of Lonsdale street to Spencer street; thence by Spencer street to Little Lonsdale street; again on the south-east by a straight line produced from the termination of the said Little Lonsdale street to the western boundary of the city.

Bounded on the west and south-west by the Sydney road and the continuation of Elizabeth street; on the south by Victoria street; on the east by Madoline street and the eastern boundary of the Prince's Park; and on the north and north-east by the boundary of the Prince's Park.

Commencing at the intersection of Errol street and Victoria street; thence by a line passing through the centre of Errol street and by a line to a gully unnamed, nine chains, more or less, north of Arden street; thence by that gully and a line west to the western boundary of the electoral district; and thence by the western and southern boundaries of the electoral district to the commencing point.
	3. Royal Park ...	Commencing at the intersection of Errol street and Victoria street; thence north by a line passing through the centre of Errol street and by a line to a gully unnamed, nine chains, more or less, north of Arden street; thence by that gully and a line west to the western boundary of the electoral district; thence by the western and northern boundaries of the electoral district to the Sydney road; thence southwards by the Sydney road to Victoria street; and thence west by Victoria street to the commencing point.

Commencing at a road on the northern boundary of the electoral district 175 chains more or less east of the sea coast; thence south by that road to the main road from Melbourne to Frankstone; thence south-easterly by that road 30 chains more or less to the junction of three roads; thence south by a road unnamed 37 chains more or less to a road running east and west; thence west 3 chains more or less; thence south by a road to the southern boundary of the electoral district; and thence by the southern, eastern, and northern boundaries of the electoral district to the commencing point.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the twenty-second year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to amend the law relating to the Registration of Parliamentary Electors*, provision is made for the performance of divers acts, matters, and things with regard to the registration of parliamentary electors in each year, at the times therein mentioned: And whereas by another Act passed in the twenty-third year of the same reign, intituled, *An Act to amend the law relating to Registration*, it is amongst other things enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to order that the time for doing any act, matter, or thing, by the first-mentioned Act required to be done, shall be postponed for such period as he shall think fit;

and whenever any such postponement shall be made the same periods of time as in the said first-mentioned Act provided between the various acts, matters, or things required by the said first-mentioned Act to be done shall be preserved: And whereas the times appointed for the registration of electors during the present year has passed, and it is expedient to appoint other times for such purpose: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order postpone the times specified in the firstly above recited Act as the times at which the several acts, matters, and things mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereunto annexed are required to be done with regard to the registration of parliamentary electors for the present year; and, with the advice aforesaid, doth hereby appoint such several acts, matters, and things to be done at the respective times mentioned in the fourth column of the same Schedule in lieu of the times mentioned in the third column thereof, that is to say:—
