PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sie Henry Barkly, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the session of Parliament holden in the twenty-third and twenty-fourth years of Her present Majesty's reign, intituled, An Act for regulating the Sale of Coven Lands and for other purposes, it is amongst other things enacted, that the Governor in Council shall have full power from time to time by proclamation to define what shall be considered Towns within the meaning of the said Act: Now therefore I, Sir Henry Barkly, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation, with the advice of the Executive Council, declare and order that the areas hereinafter defined shall be considered Towns within the meaning of the said Act, that is to say:—

Amherst, County of Talbot, Parish of Amherst.—

AMHERST, COUNTY OF TALBOT, PARISH OF AMHERST.—Commencing at a point 1 chain west of the north-west angle of allotment 1, section 8, Amherst; thence north 80 chains; thence east 80 chains; thence south 80 chains; and thence west along the north boundaries of allotments 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1, section 8, parish of Amherst, to the point of commencement.

ARARAT, COUNTY OF RIPON, PARISH OF ARARAT.—Commencing at the north-east angle of township, being a point bearing 160 chains due west of northern angle of allothent 5, section 19, in the parish of Langi-Ghiran; bounded on the east by a line bearing south 120 chains; on the south by a line bearing west 160 chains; on the west by a line bearing north 120 chains; and on the north by a line bearing 160 chains east to the commencing noint.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency SIR HENRY BARKLY, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHERAS by an Act passed in the session of parliament holden in the twenty-third and twenty-fourth years of Her present Majesty's reign, intituled, An Act for regulating the Sale of Crown Lands and for other purposes, it is amongst other things enacted, that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to proclaim that any Grown Lands in the vicinity of any town shall be a Common for the use of the inhabitants of such town, and all the inhabitants of such town, and all the inhabitants of such town, and all the inhabitants of such town the time of such proclamation, be entitled to depasture their cattle and horses on such Common, and such Common shall be called a "Town Common," and its infurine enacted, that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, or, in case such Town Common shall be included within or adjoin the limits of any municipal district, then for the municipal council of such district, with the consent of the Governor in Council, to make rules and regulations for determining how many horses and cattle every such inhabitant shall be entitled to depasture on any Town Common: Now therefore I, Sir Henry Barkly, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim that the Crown Lands in the vicinity of the several towns hereinafter mentioned comprised within the areas the description whereof is subjoined to the names of such towns respectively, shall be Towns Commons and the horse of the town the such that is to say:

AMHERST.—Commencing at the north-west angle of the town
