THE "LAST" SCHEDULE TO THE ACT 24 VICTORIA
No. 117, AMENDED.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency SIR HENRY BARKLY, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the twenty-fourth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for regulating the Sale of Crown Lands and for other purposes*, it is amongst other things enacted, that the Governor in Council shall have full power from time to time, by Proclamation, to alter any of the Forms contained in the Schedules to the said Act, and to prescribe other Forms in lieu of or in addition thereto: Now therefore I, Sir Henry Barkly, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby alter the Form of the "Last" Schedule to the said Act, and with the advice aforesaid I do hereby prescribe the Form hereunto subjoined in lieu thereof, that is to say:—

Amended Form of the "Last" Schedule.

I, _____, do solemnly and sincerely declare that I now lawfully occupy* and that I cultivate one-fourth thereof; and I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of an Act passed in the ninth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for the more effectual abolition of Oaths and Affirmations taken and made in various departments of the Government of New South Wales, and to substitute Declarations in lieu thereof, and for the suppression of voluntary and extra-judicial Oaths and Affidavits.*
