CERTAIN COURTS OF GENERAL SESSIONS POSTPONED.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable SIR JOHN HENRY THOMAS MANNERS SUTTON, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commanderin-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by The Justices of the Peace Statute 1865, it is amongst other things enacted that Courts of General Sessions of the Peace shall be holden in and for such places or districts within Victoria as the Governor in Council appoints; and the Governor in Council may from time to time define and appoint the limits and boundaries of the places or districts within which all such courts shall have jurisdiction respectively, and the places and times at which such courts shall be holden: Now therefore I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby appoint the Courts of General Sessions of the Peace at Castlemaine, Warrnambool, Belfast, and Portland respectively, to be holden on the days hereinafter mentioned, for and in lieu of the days during the months of November and December appointed by a former Proclamation for the holding of the said courts, that is to say:-

At Castlemaine, on Saturday, the fourteenth day of December instant, for and in lieu of the third instant.

At Warrnambool, on Wednesday, the eighth day of January next ensuing, for and in lieu of the twenty-seventh day of November now last past

At Belfast, on Friday, the tenth day of January next ensuing, for and in lieu of the twenty-ninth day of November now last

At Portland, on Monday, the thirteenth day of January next ensuing, for and in lieu of the second day of December instant.

Given under my Hand and the Scal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this fourth day of December, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, and in the thirty-first year of Her Majesty's reign.
