NOTICE TO MARINERS.

STEWART'S LIGHTS, BEOKEN BAY.

On and after Monday, the 20th July, two temporary fixed lights will be exhibited on Barrenjuey, the inner south headland of Broken Bay.

The lights will be situated E.S.E. and W.N.W. from each other at a distance of 1,180 feet apart, the higher one being 347,

and the lower one 315, feet above high-water mark, and they will be visible at a distance to seaward of about 12 miles.

Both lights will be eclipsed between the bearings of S. and S.S.E. ‡ E., to prevent them from being seen over the land which recedes from the Outer South Head, and also to ensure a vessel to pass a safe distance off the South Head, when running with the lights in sight for the purpose of obtaining anchorage in Broken Bay.

The lower, or outer light, will be lost sight of in rounding Barrenjuer, but the upper light will be a good guide for coasters bound to Pittwater, or for large vessels anxious to obtain shelter in Flint and Steel Bay.

OFFICIAL information is hereby given of the erection of a Lighthouse off the southern end of Horseshoe Shoal, Cape Fear River, from which there will be shown, on and after the 9th of March, 1808, a fard white light of the lifth order, illuminating the entire horizon, and can be seen from a distance of eleven miles in clear weather.

There is a fog-bell attached to this station, which will be sounded once every ten seconds.

The light is 37 feet 6 inches above ordinary tides, and the depth of water at the station is four and a half feet.

The structure is iron screw-piles, painted red; the superstructure is wooden, painted white, surmounted by a black lantern.

W HEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of Victoria, passed in the session held in the twenty-eighth year of Her Majesty's reign (No. 265), called The Police Offences Statute-1865, it is annongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council may by proclamation in the Government Gazette extend all or any of the provisions contained in Part 1. of the said Statute to any city, town, district, or place in Victoria, and may define the limits of any such city, town, district, or place, and vary and alter such limits, and may revoke any such proclamation; and upon any such proclamation the provisions so proclaimed shall extend to and be in force in such city, town, district, or place: Now therefore I, the Governor of Victoria, do, with the advice of the Executive Council, by this my Proclamation, extend the provisions contained in sections V., VII, VIII, IX, and X. of Part I, of the said Statute to

THE VICTORIA COAL COMPANY'S LEASE OF CROWN LANDS ON THE SOUTH BANK OF THE YARRA FORFEITED.

The transverse section of the street, court or alley (where the water-channels are on the sides), is to show a roadway whose crown shall be one inch above the kerbs of the footways, and the fail from the crown to the water-channels shall not be less than one (1) in twenty-five (25).

Each street, court or alley shall have a bluestone pitched water-channel, either at each of its sides or in its centre, of sufficient capacity to meet the required drainage for the same, the width of said channel or channels in no instance to be less than two (2) feet.

The pitchers to be nine (9) inches wide, and from six (6) to nine (9) inches deep, and from nine (9) to fourteen (14) inches long, with upright sides, set in sand, and well rammed down to such section as the city surveyor may direct.

The bottom of the channel is to be seven (7) inches below the kerbstones of footpaths.

On either side of the readway there is to be, where practicable, a footpath not more than three (3) feet wide, and these are to be separated from the readway by a neatly dressed bluestone kerb from two (2) to four (4) feet long, six (6) inches wide, and fifteen (15) inches deep.

The footways are to be covered with a coat of gravel three (3) inches thick, and the surface is to fall towards the channel at the rate of one (1) in ten (10).

The roadway is to be covered with a coat of clean bluestone metal, 2½ inch gauge, nine (9) inches deep in the centre, and six (6) inches deep on the sides, and this, when necessary, covered over with a coat of good loam two (2) inches thick, and rolled with a corporation iron roller.

Whenever private residences lead from the streets, courts, or alleys, they are to be paved to the full width (of building line) with bluestone pitchers similar to those used in the channels.

All entrances from adjoining streets shall be pitched and kerbed either with four (4) inch bluestone cubes or nine (9) inch pitchers, as the city surveyor may direct, the sides being well supported with eight (8) inch stone kerbing.
