JURY DISTRICTS ALTERED.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the twenty-ninth day of January 1877.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor

Sir J. McCulloch Mr. MacPherson Mr. Kerferd

WHEREAS by The Juries Statute 1876, it was amongst other things provided that the Governor in Council might from time to time shorten, lengthen, or alter the radius of the Jury district of any Assize Sessions or County Court Town as might be deemed necessary : Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order made in pursuance of the provisions of the aforesaid Act, alter the radius of each of the undermentioned Jury Districts in the Midland and Central Bailiwicks as herein prescribed, viz .:-

Midland Bailiwick.

... The radius is reduced to fifteen miles. Castlemaine Assize Town The radius is reduced to ten miles. Maryborough Assize Town ... The radius is reduced to seven miles. Kyneton Sessions Town

Central Bailiwick.

... The radius is increased to eleven miles. Seymour County Court Town ... The radius is increased to eight miles. Dandenong County Court Town Mornington County Court Town The radius is increased to ten miles. ... The radius is increased to eleven miles Blackwood County Court Town

And the Honorable George Briscoe Kerferd, Her Majesty's Attorney-General for Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
