PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir GEORGE FERGUSON BOWEN, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by *The Licensing Act 1876* (No. 566, sec. 14) it was amongst other things enacted that it should be lawful for the Governor in Council from time to time upon the application in writing of the council of any municipality to proclaim any part of the municipal district of such municipality, to be defined by such council, not being a borough having a population of Five hundred persons liable to be rated, as shown by the rate-book, a special area; and it was further enacted that the fee which should be paid for a publican's license in respect of premises situated within a special area should be Ten pounds only; and the Governor in Council might from time to time revoke any proclamation made under the authority of the above recited section of the said Act: And whereas by a Proclamation, under the hand of the Governor and the seal of the Colony, bearing date the twenty-ninth day of December 1876, the shire of Lowan, save and except the area within five miles of the townships of Dimboola and Lawloit, was proclaimed a part within which certificates for publicans' £10 licenses might be granted: And whereas it is expedient to revoke the portion of the said Proclamation relating to the said district: Now therefore I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby revoke the said Proclamation so far as it constituted a £10 licensing district; and with the advice aforesaid I do hereby proclaim as a special area under the provisions of the fourteenth section of the Act above recited the locality hereinafter described, within which the fee to be paid for a publican's license shall be Ten pounds only, that is to say:—

The Shire of Lowan, save and excepting within five miles of the township of Dimboola.
