MATTERS BETWEEN THE TOWN OF GEELONG AND THE BOROUGH OF GEELONG WEST ADJUSTED.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the fifteenth day of January 1877.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor

WHEREAS by the "Local Government Act 1874" (38 Vict. No. 506) it was amongst other things enacted, that, notwithstanding anything contained in the Act numbered LIV. or in the said Act, the Governor in Council might, subject to the provisions thereinbefore contained, constitute such portion of the Town of Geelong as is described in the twenty-second Schedule to the said Act, or so much thereof as to the Governor in Council should seem fit, either with or without any land lying outside the said town and not contained in any other borough, a borough under the said Act: And whereas it was further enacted that the Governor in Council should, in and by the Order in Council for such constitution as last aforesaid, determine in what proportion the council of the borough so to be constituted should contribute to all payments to be made under the Acts of the seventeenth year of Her Majesty's reign, No. XXIII., and of the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign, No. XXII., in respect of the loans thereunder contracted; and that where, in consequence of the exercise of any of the foregoing powers, any rights liabilities or matters require to be adjusted, the Governor in Council might by any order settle and adjust the same, and that the council of the said borough should out of the borough fund make such payments in the manner and at the times directed in the said order to the treasurer of the said town: And whereas by an Order of the Governor in Council made on the twenty-eighth day of May 1875 a portion of the part of the said Town of Geelong described in the said twenty-second Schedule to the said Act was constituted a borough by the name of the Borough of Geelong West: And whereas all payments have been satisfied in respect of the loans contracted under the Acts 17 Victoria No. XXIII., and 18 Victoria No. XXII.: And whereas in consequence of the exercise of the power to constitute the said Borough certain rights liabilities or matters require to be adjusted by the Governor in Council: Now therefore the representatives of the corporation of the said Town of Geelong and the said Borough of Geelong West respectively having been heard, and the proofs allegations and documents submitted on the part of the said corporations having been considered, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth order as follows:—

1. The council of the said Borough of Geelong West shall pay to the Treasurer of the Town of Geelong the sum of £2242 18s. 11d. (such amount having been ascertained as set forth in the first Schedule hereto) in the following manner, that is to say, the sum of £357 16s. 3d., within one calendar month from and after the date of this Order and the sum of £1885 2s. 8d., upon the several dates on which the instalments of principal and interest respectively fall due as set forth in the said first Schedule.

2. The council of the said Borough of Geelong West shall pay to the Treasurer of the Town of Geelong the sum of £475 17s. 6d. within one calendar month from and after the date of this Order (such amount having been ascertained as set forth in the second Schedule hereto.)

3. The council of the said Borough of Geelong West shall pay to the Treasurer of the Town of Geelong the sum of £134 7s. 6d. (being the balance due for fire-plugs within the said borough) within one calendar month from and after payment for the same has been made to Her Majesty's Government by the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Town of Geelong.
