WHEREAS by The Juries Statute, 1876, it was amongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council might, by any Order or Orders published in the Government Gazette on or before the first day of January A.D. One thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, extend the time or times, or alter the date or dates within or on or before which any notice is by the said Act required to be given, or any publication to be made, or any act, duty, or thing to be done: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order direct that the times or dates prescribed in Part III. of the said Act be during the year 1877 further extended or altered to the times or dates hereinafter mentioned, viz.:—
