PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir George Ferguson Bowin, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of The Bank Holidays Act 1873, I, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation appoint

THURSDAY THE 12TH OF DECEMBER INSTANT
a special day to be observed as a Bank Half-Holiday in the City of Melbourne and the suburbs thereof from the hour of Twelve noon;

 ${\bf Tuesday\ tue\ 10 tn\ of\ December\ instant}$ a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Portland ;

Wednesday the 18th of December instant a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Murtoa, Rupanyup, and Minyip.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this ninth day of December, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, and the forty-second year of Her Majesty's reign.
