PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The Most Honorable George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, Earl of Mulgrave, Viscount Normanby, and Baron Mulgrave of Mulgrave, all in the County of York, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; and Baron Mulgrave of New Ross, in the County of Wexford, in the Peerage of Ireland; a Member of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Administrator of the Government of the Colony of Victoria, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of The Bank Holidays Act 1873, I, the Administrator of the Government of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation appoint

Tuesday the 15th of April instant to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Colac, Eaglehawk, and Sandhurst.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this eighth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, and in the forty-second year of Her Majesty's reign.
