EXTERMINATION OF RABBITS.

THE Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulations, viz. :—
REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE EXTERMINATION OF RABBITS ON CROWN LANDS IN THE MALLEE DISTRICTS.

1. The Governor in Council shall, on the recommendation of the Board of Land and Works, allow a remission of rent to the extent of (£1 10s.) One pound and ten shillings for each (£1) One pound expended in the destruction of rabbits on Crown lands by the licensee, authorized as hereinafter prescribed, of any run in the Mallee districts.

2. Any licensee wishing to obtain such remission of rent shall apply in writing to that effect to the Honorable the Minister of Lands and Agriculture, and shall specify in such application the name of the run and the area of Crown lands on which he may desire to destroy rabbits, and the maximum amount which he may intend to expend on such run. The Minister shall, if he think fit, authorize the expenditure of the sum so specified or of any less amount.

3. Each licensee, so authorized shall, in order to obtain such remission of rent, furnish a statutory declaration setting forth that the amount on which his claim is based has been expended on Crown lands only, and shall furnish receipted vouchers for all such expenditure to the Crown Lands Bailiff for the district for examination and transmission to the Minister.

4. The Crown Lands Bailiff for the district shall at all times on demand have access to the books and accounts relating to the destruction of rabbits, and shall be furnished with such reasonable information on application to the licensee of any run as he may in the execution of his duty require.
