RULES AND REGULATIONS.

9. The Executive Committee shall consist of the President, the Vice-Presidents, and sixteen ordinary members. The Executive Committee shall have full authority to execute all the powers conferred upon the Commissioners; but such Committee shall report their proceedings from time to time to the Commissioners.

10. The President shall be a member of all Committees. Three members shall form a quorum of each Committee, excepting the Executive, five members of which shall form a quorum, and the rules which regulate the proceedings of the meetings of the Commissioners shall apply to meetings of Committees.
