QUARANTINE OF THE SHIP "BRITISH SCEPTRE."

A CASE of Small-pox having occurred on board of the ship *British Sceptre* on her voyage to this colony and the same having been reported to the Government, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has ordered that the said vessel and her crew be detained in Quarantine, at the Quarantine Station at Point Nepean, until released by the Health Officer.

All persons are hereby required to take notice accordingly.
