REDUCED RATES OF POSTAGE ON LETTERS, PACKETS, AND NEWSPAPERS TRANSMITTED *VIA* BRINDISI.

THE Governor in Council has been pleased to approve of the following reduced rates being charged on Letters, Packets, and Newspapers posted in Victoria for transmission to the United Kingdom *via* Brindisi:—

LETTERS—

Not exceeding half an ounce	6d.
For every additional half-ounce or portion of half-ounce	6d.

PACKETS—

Not exceeding one ounce	1d.
Exceeding one ounce but not exceeding two ounces	2d.
Exceeding two ounces but not exceeding four ounces	4d.
For every additional four ounces or portion of four ounces	4d.

NEWSPAPERS—

For each newspaper	1d.

REDUCTION IN RATES OF POSTAGE ON LETTERS, ETC., TRANSMITTED FROM VICTORIA TO FIJI.

THE Governor in Council has been pleased to approve of the following reduced rates being charged on Letters, Packets, and Newspapers transmitted from Victoria to Fiji:—

LETTERS—

For every half-ounce or portion of half-ounce	2d.

PACKETS—

Not exceeding one ounce	1d.
Exceeding one ounce but not exceeding two ounces	2d.
Exceeding two ounces but not exceeding four ounces	4d.
For every additional four ounces or portion of four ounces	8d.

For each newspaper	1d.
