GENERAL ROLLS OF ELECTORS RECTIFIED.

At an Executive Council held at Government House, Melbourne, the tenth day of July 1880.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor.

Mr. Anderson

Mr. Bent.

WHEREAS by *The Electoral Act 1865* it was amongst other things enacted that where any accidental or unavoidable impediment, misfeasance, or omission should have happened in the preparation or transmission or printing of any general roll or supplementary roll or ordinary electoral roll or roll of ratepaying electors, the Governor in Council might take all such measures as might be necessary for removing such impediment or rectifying such misfeasance or omission, or might declare any such roll valid as to and notwithstanding such impediment, misfeasance, or omission; and every such Order in Council should state specifically the nature of the impediment, misfeasance, or omission, and should be forthwith published in the *Government Gazette*: And whereas in the preparation of the General Lists of Electors in December last, the names of the persons set forth in the subjoined schedule were accidentally omitted to be inserted therein by the Electoral Registrars for such divisions: And whereas the said persons are by virtue of Electors Rights held by them, entitled to appear on the General Rolls for the Electoral Divisions mentioned in the said schedule hereto: Now therefore the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, under and by virtue of the power in him vested by the 68th section of the said Act, doth by this present order direct that the General Rolls of Electors for the divisions of the Electoral Districts hereinafter mentioned be rectified by inserting in such General Rolls the names contained in the subjoined Schedule so omitted as aforesaid, and that the said Divisional Rolls so rectified be reprinted accordingly. And the Governor in Council doth hereby also declare valid the Rolls so rectified.
