### ROLL OF ELECTORS DECLARED VALID.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the fifth day of August 1880. PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor

Mr. Berry Mr. Patterson.

WHEREAS by The Electoral Act 1865 it is amongst other things enacted that where any accidental or unavoidable impediment, misfeasance, or omission shall have happened in the preparation or transmission or printing of any general roll or supplementary roll or ordinary electoral roll or roll of ratepaying electors, the Governor in Council may take all such measures as may be necessary for removing such impediment or rectifying such misfeasance or omission, or may declare any such roll valid as to and notwithstanding such impediment, misfeasance, or omission, and every such Order in Council shall state specifically the nature of the impediment, misfeasance, or omission, and shall be forthwith published in the Government Gazette: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, under and by virtue of the power in him vested by the 68th section of the Act No. 279, doth hereby declare valid the Supplementary Roll 1880 for the Goornong division of the Electoral District of Mandurang, notwithstanding its having been revised on a day not legally appointed for that purpose.

And the Honorable Graham Berry, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
