PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency The Most Honorable George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, Earl of Mulgrave, Viscount Normanby, and Baron Mulgrave of Mulgrave, all in the County of York, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; and Baron Mulgrave of New Ross, in the County of Wexford, in the Peerage of Ireland; a Member of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of The Bank Holidays Act 1873, I, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation appoint

FRIDAY THE 20TH APRIL INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Donald;

SATURDAY THE 21ST APRIL INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Kerang and Boort;

THURSDAY AND FRIDAY THE 26TH AND 27TH APRIL INSTANT

to be observed as Bank Half-Holidays at Coleraine, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon each day.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this sixteenth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, and in the forty-sixth year of Her Majesty's reign.
