ACT OF PARLIAMENT.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir HENRY BROUGHAM LOCH, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of Victoria, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bill passed by the Parliament of Victoria, the title whereof is hereinafter set forth, that is to say:—

An Act to bring into operation in respect of the Colony of Victoria an Act of the Imperial Parliament intituled "An Act to constitute a Federal Council of Australasia."

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this ninth day of December, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, and in the forty-ninth year of Her Majesty's reign.

THE FEDERAL COUNCIL OF AUSTRALASIA.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir HENRY BROUGHAM LOCH, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland passed in the forty-eighth and forty-ninth year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled "An Act to constitute a Federal Council of Australasia," it is enacted and called the Federal Council of Australasia: And it is further enacted by the said Act that the said Act shall not come into operation in respect of any colony until the Legislature of such colony shall have passed an Act or Ordinance declaring that the same shall be in force therein, and appointing a day on and from which such operation shall take effect, nor until four colonies at the least shall have passed such an Act or Ordinance: And whereas four of the said Australasian colonies have severally passed such Acts or Ordinances: And whereas by an Act of the Parliament of Victoria it is enacted that the coming of the said Act last recited of the Parliament of the United Kingdom into operation in Victoria shall be notified by the Governor by Proclamation: Now therefore I, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation notify and declare that the said Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom, intituled "An Act to constitute a Federal Council of Australasia," has come into and is in operation in Victoria on and from this date.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this ninth day of December, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, and in the forty-ninth year of Her Majesty's reign.
