IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the eighty-eighth section of *The Public Service Act 1883*, I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

WEDNESDAY THE 17TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday at Castlemaine, within the Borough of Chewton, and the Shire of Numurkah;

THURSDAY THE 18TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shire and Borough of St. Arnaud, and the Shires of Lowan and Kara Kara;
