#### ACT OF PARLIAMENT.

#### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Henry Brougham Loch, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c., THE Governor of Victoria, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bill passed by the Parliament of Victoria, the title whereof is hereinafter set forth, that is to say:—

"An Act to further amend The Waterworks Act 1880, and for other purposes."

#### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Henry Brougham Looh, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the eighty-eighth section of The Public Service Act 1883, and in the fifth section of The Bank Holidays Act 1873, I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

FRIDAY THE 2ND DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT\* a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Buninyong;

TUESDAY THE 6TH AND WEDNESDAY THE 7TH DAYS OF DECEMBER NEXT \*
to be observed as Public and Bank Holidays at Minyip and Rupanyup; and as Public and Bank Half-Holidays at Murtoa, from the hour of One o'clock p.m. on each day.
