PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Henny Brougham Looh, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the eighty-eighth section of The Public Service Act 1883, and the fifth section of The Bank Holidays Act 1873, I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

FRIDAY THE 11TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Numurkah;

TUESDAY THE 15TH AND WEDNESDAY THE 16TH DAYS OF MARCH INSTANT

to be observed as Public and Bank Half-Holidays at Eaglehawk, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day;

WEDNESDAY THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday at Dunolly, and as a Public Holiday within the Shire of Bet Bet;

THURSDAY THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT

to be observed as a Public Holiday at Kerang, Scarsdale, Wycheproof, and within the Shire of Bet Bet; and as a Bank Holiday at Kyneton; THURSDAY THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT

to be observed as Public and Bank Holidays at Coleraine, Malmabury, and Merino; within the Boroughs of Belfast, Koroit, Portland, St. Arnaud, and Wangaratta; and within the Shires of Huntly, Maffra, Mansfield, Marong, Rodney, Seymour, and Traralgon;

FRIDAY THE 18TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shire of Bright;

SATURDAY THE 19TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Bright; TUESDAY THE 22ND DAY OF MARCH INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Hampden;

THURSDAY THE 24TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the North Riding of the Shire of Ripon;

FRIDAY THE 25TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT to be observed as a Public and Bank Half-Holiday within the Shire of Benalla, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon;

WEDNESDAY THE 6TH DAY OF APRIL NEXT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Kyneton.
