PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Henry Brougham Loch, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

In pursuance of the provisions contained in the eighty-eighth section of The Public Service Act 1883, and in the fifth section of The Bank Holidays Act 1873, I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

THURSDAY THE 15TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shire of Dundas; and as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Rutherglen; FRIDAY THE 16TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER-INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Ballarat; and as a Public Holiday within the Shire of Dundas;

WEDNESDAY THE 21st DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday at Bridgewater-on-Loddon, within the Shire of Dimboola, and within the West, South, and Central Ridings of the Shire of St. Arnaud;

TUESDAY THE 27TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday at St. James, and within the Western Riding of the Shire of Waranga; and as a Bank Holiday at Elmore; Wednesday the 28th day of September instant

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Numurkah; and within the Western Riding of the Shire of Yarrawonga;

THURSDAY THE 29TH AND FRIDAY THE 30TH DAYS OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT to be observed as Public and Bank Holidays at Horsham, within the Shire of Dimboola; and within the West, South, and Central Ridings of the Shire of St. Arnaud;

Wednesday the 5th day of October next

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday at Corop, Echuca, and within the Shire of Kara Kara;

TUESDAY THE 11TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday at Avenel, Seymour, and Nagambie;

Wednesday the 12th and Thursday the 13th days of October next

to be observed as Public and Bank Half-Holidays at Warrnambool, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day;

THURSDAY THE 13TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday at Murchison and Rushworth.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this twelfth day of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, and in the fifty-first year of Her Majesty's reign.

GOD SAVE THE QUEEN !

"THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1885."

IN compliance with an application in writing under the provisions of the 29th section of The Factories and Shops Act 1885 [49]

Vict. No. 862], and after due inquiry, I, the Chief Secretary of Victoria, being the responsible Minister of the Crown for the time being administering the said Act, do hereby suspend the operation of the first clause of the said section 29 in the

Factory of Messrs, George Robertson and Co., 33 and 35 Little Collins street west, Melbourne,

from the date hereof, to the 30th instant, upon these express conditions, that is to say :-

1. That no person or persons shall employ in the said factory any female for more than fifty-seven hours in any one week in preparing or manufacturing articles for trade or sale.

2. That no female shall be so employed for more than forty-eight hours in any one week without her consent.

3. That a copy of this Order be kept conspicuously and continually posted in such factory for the information of all concerned. Given under my hand, at Melbourne, this ninth day of September 1887.
