PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir WILLIAM CLEAVER FRANCIS ROBINSON, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Administrator of the Government of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the eighty-eighth section of *The Public Service Act 1883*, and in the fifth section of the *Bank Holidays Act 1873*, I, the Administrator of the Government of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this Proclamation appoint

THURSDAY THE 14TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shire of Narracan;

MONDAY THE 18TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shire of Marong and at Warrnambool, and as a Bank Holiday at Violet Town and Warrnambool;

TUESDAY THE 19TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shires of Buln Buln and Warragul, and as a Bank Holiday at Drouin and Warragul;

WEDNESDAY THE 20TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Western Riding of the Shire of Waranga, and as a Bank Holiday at St. Arnaud;

THURSDAY THE 21ST DAY OF MARCH INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shires of Buln Buln, Narracan, and Warragul; and as a Bank Holiday at Drouin and Warragul;

WEDNESDAY THE 27TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Borough of Maryborough.\*

"THE LICENSING ACT 1885."—LICENSING DISTRICTS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir WILLIAM CLEAVER FRANCIS ROBINSON, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Administrator of the Government of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by *The Licensing Act 1885* (No. 857, section 15) it is amongst other things enacted that, for the purposes of the said Act, Victoria should be divided into licensing districts, and that each licensing district should consist of one division of an Electoral District, as described in *The Electoral Act Amendment Act 1876*, or in any Act amending or repealing the same, or constituting new electoral districts or divisions thereof: And, further, that every licensing district should be proclaimed by the Governor in Council, and the same should be notified in the *Government Gazette*, together with the name by which the same should be known: Now therefore I, the Administrator of the Government of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim the various divisions of the Electoral Districts as described and named in the Second Schedule to *The Electoral Act Amendment Act 1885*, and set forth in the subjoined schedule, to be Licensing Districts within the meaning and for the purposes of the said Act, to be known by the said respective names (that is to say):—
