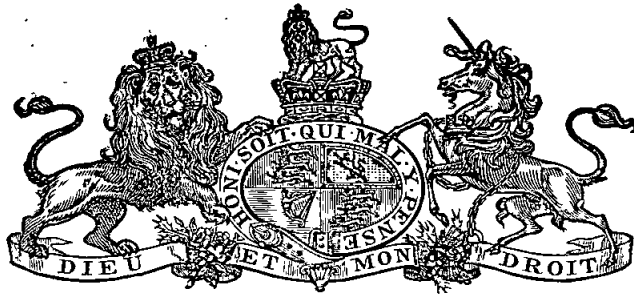

NOTE.—In making their Census Returns of Live Stock, the householders were requested to enter all the animals kept on the land they occupied, and, in some instances, this extended into more than one county. As in these cases the numbers in each such county were not known, the whole have been tabulated as being in the county in which the householders' residence was situated, and for this reason the numbers in the different counties are not always strictly correct. This, however, would not affect the numbers for the whole of Victoria given in the lowest line of the table. The figures have been finally checked.
