PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), 1, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

WEDNESDAY, THE 14TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 15TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT,  
to be observed as Public Half-Holidays at Bendigo, from 12 o'clock noon on each day;

THURSDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,  
to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Port Fairy and the Shire of Belfast;

MONDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,  
to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Stawell, and as a Bank Holiday at Stawell;

WEDNESDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,  
to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Avoca and Talbot, and as a Bank Holiday at Mornington;

THURSDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,  
to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Chiltern, and as a Bank Holiday at Geelong and throughout the Borough of Rutherglen;

FRIDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,  
to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Shepparton,\* and as a Bank Holiday at Shepparton;

TUESDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,  
to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Shepparton;

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,  
to be observed as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday throughout the Borough of Creswick, as a Public Holiday at Sale and throughout the Shires of Avoca, Avon, Creswick, and Seymour, and as a Bank Holiday at Allendale, Kingston, Nagambie, and Sineaton, and throughout the Borough of Sale;

FRIDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,  
to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Yarra Glen;

WEDNESDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,  
to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Camperdown and Heathcote;

THURSDAY, THE 12TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 13TH DAYS OF NOVEMBER NEXT,  
to be observed as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Omeo;

FRIDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,  
to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Creswick and the Shire of Creswick, and as a Bank Holiday at Kingston.
